---

- 1 This show is held under PCGB Rules and Exhibitors making entries agree to be bound by such rules (this also applies to non-PCGB members).

### Welfare

- 2 The show is run under DEFRA/APHA regulations for bird gatherings.
- 3 The Show Committee will refuse admission to the Show of any birds which, in their opinion, are suffering from any disease or infestation, and comply with current DEFRA legislation on exhibit checks. A CPH number is mandatory and should be put on the entry form. (Go to [www.gov.uk](http://www.gov.uk) for further details)
- 4 It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor or his/her representative to water and feed all his/her exhibits after judging and for the Welfare Officer to ensure that this is carried out.
- 5 DEFRA Regulations require that Veterinary cover to be on call for shows. Any charges incurred will be the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor of the bird requiring treatment.

### GDPR

**To comply with the General Data Protection Regulations (May 2018) HPPC have introduced the following two rules.**

- 6 The names of exhibitors will be displayed in the show catalogue. Exhibitors' home addresses, telephone/mobile numbers and email addresses will not be displayed in the show catalogue. (Midland OEG Fowl Club omitted from catalogue)
- 7 Show entry forms and the related computer data will be held by HPPC for a period of one year.
