The show will be held under the rules of the Poultry Club of Great Britain and judged to the standards published in the  $7^{th}$  edition British Poultry Standards.

## Rules

Exhibitors MUST comply with the following:

- 1. The show will comply with the regulations APHA and DEFRA have issued.
- 2. No bantam egg to exceed  $42.5g/1\frac{1}{2}$  ozs.
- 3. No live poultry (any type) must be brought to the show. 'Car boot' sales will be reported to the authorities.
- 4. No hatching eggs to be sold or given away.
- 5. Exhibitors are required to take all their exhibits home (except broken eggs which will be disposed of by the show organisers). It is requested that NEW egg boxes or trays are used to transport exhibits. Any other carrier should be clean and disinfected.
- 6. Eggs must be clean, and free of dirt or faeces.
- 7. Entries cannot be accepted from premises which are currently in a Protection Zone (PZ) or Surveillance Zone (SZ).
- 8. Details of exhibitors will be retained for 6 months by the organisers and APHA will be notified the event is taking place.
- 9. The club reserves the right to appoint additional judge(s) should entries require it.
